DISCOVER DANJUGAN: Php 1,000 per person

- 3-hour guided program tour
- Boat transfers from Brgy. Bulata & back
- Activities with gears provided: snorkeling, skin diving, kayaking, trekking, birdwatching & learning about wildlife
- Station for unlimited coffee & drinking water
- Boat pickup schedules: 8:00 AM and 1:00 PM

DAYTRIP: Php 2,000 per person

- 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM (or max. 8 hours stay)
- Guided program tour
- Boat transfers from Brgy. Bulata & back
- Lunch, snacks, w/ a station for unlimited coffee & drinking water
- Activities with gears provided: snorkeling, skin diving, kayaking, trekking, birdwatching & learning about wildlife
- Boat pickup schedules: 8:00-9:00 AM

OVERNIGHT @ MORAY LAGOON CAMP: Php 3,000 per person

- Accommodations in our open-air eco-cabanas with individual mattresses and mosquito nets (Shared toilets/showers)
- Guided program tour
- Boat transfers from Brgy. Bulata & back
- Lunch, dinner, breakfast, snacks in between, w/ a station for unlimited coffee & drinking water
- Activities with gears provided: snorkeling, skin diving, kayaking, trekking, birdwatching & learning about wildlife
- Check-in time: 12:00 NN, check-out time: 10:00 AM

OVERNIGHT @ TYPHOON BEACH CAMP: Php 4,000 per person

- Accommodations in private rooms (Ensuite toilets/showers)
- Guided program tour
- Boat transfers from Brgy. Bulata & back
- Lunch, dinner, breakfast, snacks in between, w/ a station for unlimited coffee & drinking water
- Activities with gears provided: snorkeling, skin diving, kayaking, trekking, birdwatching & learning about wildlife
- Check-in time: 12:00 NN, check-out time: 10:00 AM

OTHER TERMS

- Ages 0-6 are free of charge, ages 7-12 at 50% off
- Ages 60 and above with senior citizen's ID get 20% off
- Two nights at 10% off / Three nights or more at 20% off
- Only one type of discount may be applied for each patron



USER'S FEES

The island is surrounded by the Danjugan Island Marine Reserve and Sanctuaries (DIMRS) locally declared as marine protected area by the municipality of Cauayan. Environmental User's Fee of Php 100/person/day will be separately collected upon arrival; with tickets issued on behalf of the DIMRS. This User's Fee is required by local government for conservation of its municipal waters.



HOW TO GET THERE



Danjugan Island is located 3 km off the shores of Brgy. Bulata, Municipality of Cauayan, Negros Occidental, Philippines. From Bacolod City, take the Negros South Road. After the KM 146 / Welcome to Bulata marker, there are 3 possible boat pickup points:

- Antol
- Crossing Remollos / Purok Tres Bulata
- Pantalan / Old Bulata Port

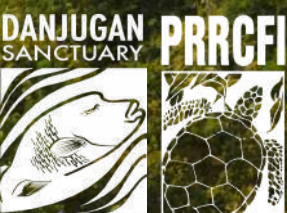
The island team will contact you to coordinate your arrival; we will also provide you the contact number of our boat scheduler upon confirming your visit.

HOW TO ARRANGE A VISIT AS PATRONS

1. Fill out the **Application Form** at www.bit.ly/danjuganisland
2. Expect feedback via email for availability and payment details.
3. Reply with images of the ff. requirements within 7 days before arrival (please comply w/ local pandemic-related travel protocols to keep the community safe):
 - Barangay certification* for each visitor (declaring persons are not under quarantine/under monitoring)
 - Proof of payment for package costs (bank deposit slip/online transfer)
4. Upon receipt of the requirements, we will send you a Patrons Welcome Letter confirming your visit to Danjugan Island.

*We will update requirements when there are changes in guidelines set by the LGU.

THE ISLAND LIFE

Our philosophy of travel is low-impact and low-volume. We invite our visitors to have a meaningful experience with utmost respect for the island's ecosystems. Although in isolation, the island is a place where we can nurture a deep connection with nature.

In Danjugan Island, we...

- Take nothing but photos, leave nothing but bubbles, and kill nothing but time. (Way of Life)
- Practice social distancing and follow standard & COVID-19 protocols for the safety of guests & staff. (Health & Safety)
- Enjoy local dishes, with locally sourced ingredients, organic if possible. Dietary requests can be arranged. (Food)
- Conserve freshwater and solar-powered electricity stored for use of all visitors, so we practice mindful consumption. There are no air-conditioned rooms, hot showers, and WiFi. Mobile reception may be limited. (Water & Energy)
- Clean as we go, reduce, reuse and recycle when we can. (Waste Management)
- Protect wildlife by not starting bonfires, making loud noises, nor bringing invasive species. We love pets, but they cannot enter the sanctuary. (Keeping the Wild)
